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Declaration relating to the application of the European Regulation EC n. 1907/2006 REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals)

Referring to the above-mentioned Regulation, we confirm our commitment to compliance with the European Union's REACH Regulation (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals, EC No. 1907/2006). Although our company, FEMTOprint, is based in Switzerland, we recognize the importance of adhering to REACH requirements for our products that are supplied to the European Union.

Our activity is classified as Downstream User (DU) activity, as we solely use substances and mixtures purchased from suppliers within the European Union. Consequently, our activity is not configurable as activity of production and/or importation of substances and mixtures from outside the EU (Article 3, Regulation 1907/06).

Our Company ensures compliance with REACH Regulation by verifying our upstream suppliers fully comply with their REACH obligations regarding pre-registration, registration, authorization, and preparation of exposure scenarios and safety sheets, as required by Articles 6, 31, and 55 of the Regulation.

Our production process consists in the third-party design, development and manufacturing of precision 3D glass devices, classified as "ARTICLES" under REACH. The glass products manufactured by FEMTOprint do not contain substances intended to be released under normal and foreseeable conditions and are therefore not subject to by Article 7.1 of the REACH Regulation. Concerning Article 7.2 of the REACH Regulation, which requires notification of substances in products, if such substances are of high concern, exceed 0.1% (w/w) and exceed 1 ton/year per importer or producer, and Article 33.1, which requires suppliers to inform customers if the ARTICLE contains a substance of very high concern (SVHC - substances potentially to be included in Annex XIV). Glass is treated as a UVCB substance (Substance of Unknown or Variable composition, Complex reaction products or biological materials) under REACH and is generally exempt from registration (see Annex II of Commission Regulation 987/2008 for Annex V exemption 11).

Additionally, glass is not classified as a hazardous substance and is unlikely to be listed as a substance of high concern. As a result, our glass products fall into the category of articles without deliberate release of substances and do not require to be registered under REACH.

Our compliance strategy is supported by guidance from the Swiss Federal Office for the Environment (FOEN), which provides detailed information on how Swiss companies can adhere to REACH regulations when exporting to the EU.
